The compost from the machine will be more mature if it is stored on a maturation bay. We recommend that between the garden seasons the compost is stored on a maturation bay rather than in plastic bags.



BRF SAGOGANGEN

The pictures shows a storage place for earth and compost in a residential area with 506 apartments where they have eight machines installed. They produce about 8 tonnes of compost annually.

The measurement of the maturation bay for the compost is about 4 x 6 meter and is divided in three different sectors as shown in the lowest picture.



MATURATION BAY

BRF GINSTEN

This is a simpler solution. They have 5 different sectors in a group of trees. Here they store wood and bushes and shred when the sector is filled. They also store compost in two of the sectors. Measurement of each sector is about 2 x 3 m. In each sector they have a pile of compost that lays directly on the ground so worms and microflora can get into the compost and make it really mature.



BRF BATSMANSTORPET

This is a smaller version with a roof. This is installed in an area with four small Big Hanna's. The maturation bay is installed directly on the ground allowing worms and microflora to make the compost mature. Measurement of the sectors are about 1 x 1 meter per sector so in total 1 x 3 meter.



SIZE OF MATURATION BAY

For a T240 you need about 2 x 2 meters for each sector. For T40-120 you need about 1 x 1 meter in 2 or three sectors.

HOW TO

You build a pile of compost in the first sector and when it is about 1 meter in height you start building a pile in the 2nd sector. While building a pile in the third sector you should empty and use the compost in the first pile.

To speed up the process in the maturation bays you can turn the compost in the piles once a month. If you not are turning it, it takes a little longer before you have the dark rich compost to use in your garden.

To get a really good compost the compost from Big Hanna can be mixed with leaves, grass cuttings etc. If for some reason the maturation bay smell a little bit you can cover the compost with soil.

FERTILIZER

By mixing the compost with one part of compost and 5 parts of soil the compost is ready to use.
